When Will I need To Review My Medication?

When you collect your medication, check with the pharmacy how many issues are left.

If there are no issues left, call the Cam & Uley Family Practice Prescription Service on 01453 861755 to re new your pathfinder.

It may be that the GP would like some monitoring such as blood tests and blood pressure checks. These are usually carried out within your birth month.



Some Items are not suitable to be set up for a Pathfinder prescription, for example: Inhalers, Insulins and anything that is taken 'When needed'.



Please be aware that if you use Pharmacy2U for your prescription deliveries, you will still need to contact them monthly to release your prescription, even if you have a Pathfinder set up.

What Is A Pathfinder Prescription?

A pathfinder prescription means that your GP has authorised a set number of prescriptions and sent them to your chosen pharmacy.

You will not need to order your medication every month, you can go straight to the pharmacy and collect it for the duration of the Pathfinder

When Will My Prescription Be Ready To Collect?

Most prescriptions will be available on a 28-day cycle.

Your pharmacy will be able to tell you the date your next prescription will be ready.
